

### **Financial Assistance and Scholarships**

University has a system of incentive scholarships and grants to recognize merit and foster competition and a program of assistance to other promising, well behaved hardworking students who are in dire need of help.

25% concession in course fee is granted to students with a CGPA of 3.5 to 3.75. Students maintaining CGPA 3.75 and higher are entitled to 40% concession in Course fees.

University also provides specific scholarship 25 % concession on admission and monthly tuition fee to serving or retired personnel from Defence Services and members of their immediate family.

University also provides 50% concession in Course fee to employees and their children.

For siblings studying concurrently, a special concession of 50% is entitled to the first one and 25% each from 2<sup>nd</sup> onward.

It is however understood that scholarships are granted after careful evaluation of the need and potential of the applicant and cannot be claimed as a matter of course.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Candidates for enrolment in Higher Education programs run at University of EAST should present themselves at the University's Admissions Office on any working day and obtain Admission Forms, course outlines and general informational literature concerning the University.

The form should be filled carefully and submitted to the Admissions Officer. On submission of application the candidate will sign assurance (s) relating to production of personal and education documents on demand.

A non refundable fee of Rs 100/- will be deposited as Assessment Fee along with the application in cash or in the form of Bank Draft.

Admissions Officer will give date and time for interview with the Admissions Committee. If the Committee finds him fit, the candidate will be granted 'Provisional' Admission.

The candidates will also collect Fee Challan from the Admission office / Accounts office and deposit the amount with the bank before the given date for payment.

On receipt of confirmatory counterfoil from the Bank 'provisional' admission will be considered as 'complete' and the student would be allowed to attend classes. The process of verification of documents and authenticity of other information supplied by the student will be taken up by the Coordination office as a matter of course.
